It was chilling to experience the nothingness of the afternoon caused by the death of JESUS. It was subdued; it was a strong Presence of the GOD who died.

Thanks to the Men's Choir who led the congregation in the singing. Greg and Bev Leach; the men and the parishioners who gathered behind them made the entire celebration most meaningful and prayerful.

THE EASTER VIGIL/19 APRIL

No one can forget this evening: when, at the height of my inspired homily about the cleansing powers of water, I glanced at the tin bin [which Francis and I prepared early that morning; decorated by Nola Turner and Sr. Coral] and discovered that there was no water [it leaked without mercy and wet the sanctuary carpet] to

I remember how I felt so possessed like a "born-again" preacher screaming about the significance of water in the story of our salvation and pointing to the tin bin that Francis and I filled up with water just that morning... only to discover, to my horror, that there was no water in the container!

was lucky I was in the Sanctuary... a few meters from the members of the Parish FINANCE Committee: can't blame them if they did kill me; they agonised for months and months whether or not to lay the new carpet. And here I am... ruining it because of my [...]!

Anyway: the Blessing of the Holy Water went on as usual, without delay, using the water in the Baptismal Font - which was prepared for the baptism of Tai and Chase Thompson the following day, on Easter Sunday.

l likewise remember Jim Harmon and Anthony Michael frantically drying up the carpet and moving the tin bin away as if this will make the water come back and go on with life as usual.

I remember telling Jim, "Leave it alone, Jim. You are now the center of attention. I resent that... I should be the star here!" More laughter.

After the intentional spill of easter eggs [donated by Jim and Kay Harmon] all over the sanctuary floor [away from the wet carpet, of course] at the end of mass, Dudley McLennan, who cleans the church [with his wife, Carol], came to me in the middle of the mess and, in his cool and gentle way, said, "Don't worry, JOE, I will be here early morning to deal with the mess!" What a parishjoner! Carol must be a happy wife having such a guy.
