3. Celebrated every year on August 15, the **Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven - a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time.

The earliest printed reference to the belief that Mary's body was assumed into Heaven dates from the fourth century in a document entitled "The Falling Asleep of the Holy Mother of God."

The document is written in the voice of the Apostle John, to whom Christ on the Cross had entrusted the care of His mother, and recounts the death, laying in the tomb, and assumption of the Blessed Virgin. Tradition variously places Mary's death at Jerusalem or at Ephesus, where John was living.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven at the end of her earthly life is a defined dogma of the Catholic Church. On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII declared that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.

The Parish Mass to celebrate the Solemnity of the ASSUMPTION will be held at McLean Hostel on the 15th of August/Friday at 11:00 am.
