The Statement celebrates the place of sport in our national life, especially the way in which it brings individuals and communities together and contributes to our health and well-being. At the same time, the Statement challenges us to look at sport's darker side - the potential for violence, abuse and corruption that blemish its image and disillusion those who love it most.

From JOE...

-VERY IMPORTANT NOTE FOR ALL-

was informed that, for a few Sundays now, a mother, after receiving the Sacred Host in her hand in Holy Communion, would half the Sacred Host: she takes the half and gives the other half to her child.

THIS IS NOT ALLOWED in view of the strict requirement of the church that the recipient of Holy Communion should fully know, understand, and accept that what he/she is receiving is the Body of the Lord.

That is why we prepare the children very well for First Eucharist; this particular doctrine and teaching of the church [on the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist] is emphasised and is repeated many times during the course of the preparation sessions.

I do not want to know who this parent is; but this practice has to stop. Any parishioner who needs clarification on these issue and concern, please feel free to see me.

Maybe, this is a call for us all to "return to the basics": via "Catechetical Homilies" - homilies that deal with particular and specific doctrines and teachings of the church in very simple lay language instead of homilies that deal with the Readings taken from Scriptures.

In 2000, the Diocese of ARMIDALE, through the initiative of Bishop LUC MATTHYS, introduced: FAITH and PRACTICE.

After 14 years, it might be beneficial if it is re-visited but, this time, using the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church as a Lesson Guide. It will be a purely "teaching homily" but to be presented, as mentioned above, "in very simple lay language".
