The Bishops of Australia invite us all to pray earnestly for the Extraordinary Synod on the Family taking place in Rome 5-19 October and especially to join in a National Day of Prayer and Fasting on the 10th of October/Friday.

The theme of the Extraordinary Synod is: "The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization".

- 2. Most Rev. Paul R. Gallagher, Papal Nuncio of Australia, announced that His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed as Archbishop of Sydney the Most Rev. Anthony Colin **Fisher**, OP, who has been, until now, the Bishop of Paramatta. The Archdiocese of Sydney has been vacant since the transfer of His Eminence Cardinal George Pell to Rome as the Prefect of the Secretariat for the Economy.
