# From JOE...

#### **INFORMATION from: CENTACARE New England North West**

I received a letter from Fergus Fitzsimons, CEO of CENTACARE New England North West:

CENTACARE New England North West has been selected to deliver support and counselling services through the Rural Resilience Program [part of the Australian Government's drought assistance package to promote support services and deliver free counselling support to drought areas declared in February 2014].

The program is open to individuals, families, and couples of all ages and aims to assist those feeling the stress and pressure of the current drought but also the cumulative effects of previous hardships in rural communities.

The Rural Resilience Program offers free counselling and support to those who need it. No GP referral is required and it is open to self-referral, or referrals from friends, family, or business contacts.

The support is available at a venue to suit the individual/family - on farm, at the CENTACARE Office, at a cafe, via telephone, or even online. "Tablets" can be posted out by CENTACARE so people can sit on their lounge or in the shed for a chat.

Support and counselling could also take the form of group counselling for work environments, helping to build resilience within teams, and the broader community. The Rural Resilience Team is also available for education and in-service sessions around mental health and how to access local services.

As well as supporting people through counselling, the program can help to guide people to other streams of support, for example: financial management and financial counselling, assistance through CENTRELINK and Human Services, and understanding what other options may be available to them locally to help improve their outlook.
