There have been some recent changes to the NSW DEC Enrolment Forms for NSW State Schools: parents and carers are now required to enrol their child directly to a nominated Special Religious Education Programme.

Hereunder is the DEC Enrolment Form containing the added questions:

Special Religious Education (SRE) may be provided by approved religious groups in some schools.
