1. The Parish PASTORAL Council affirmed the presentation of a Workshop "How Mission is Transforming Me" to be presented by Sr. Coral Hedley. The Workshop will take about 2 hours & 30 minutes and will take place in the Parish MEETING Room on the 25th of November/Tuesday/5:30

The content of the workshop will help us explore how we connect with people in mission and how that transforms or changes us... to be Christ-like and so be moved with pity to show mercy.

A truth we are invited to give assent to is that we the Baptised do not have a mission. Mission belongs to God ... It is God's Mission! It is the Mission of God that God has for us.

Pope Francis reminds all of us who are baptised that we are missionary disciples. We are all called to become a living Gospel in the world.
