Special thanks to Fr. PAUL McCABE who facilitated the day again this year, his second.

Greg Leach, one of the members of the Men's Retreat Core Group, reflects about this day:

"Why would fifteen men of our Parish recently spend all of Saturday attending what they were told was to be a day of Prayer and Reflection? Why did they find themselves discussing such weighty topics as "The Big Bang Theory", "The Cosmos" and even "Transubstantiation"?

The answer was that their facilitator, Fr. Paul McCabe, wanted the men to know that despite the enormity of the cosmos, there was a vital role for this group of men in a remote part of the cosmos called Inverell.

So Fr. Paul gently steered the discussion towards the "Holiness of Being Human". As human beings we all become co-responsible for the development of Society, and there is holiness in recognising that such development is part of God's plan, that in everything we do we can see the hand of God.
