This year's theme is: "I was eyes to the blind, and feet to the lame [Job 29:15]."


In his message on the occasion of the 2015 World Day of the Sick, Pope Francis says, "Time spent with the sick is holy time."

He likewise declared, "Occasionally, our world forgets the special value of time spent at the bedside of the sick, since we are in such a rush; caught up as we are in a frenzy of doing, of producing, we forget about giving ourselves freely, taking care of others, being responsible for others. Behind this attitude there is often a lukewarm faith which has forgotten the Lord's words: 'You did it unto me' [Matthew 25:40]"

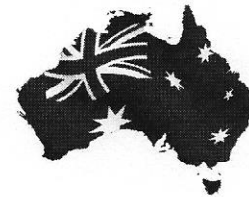
