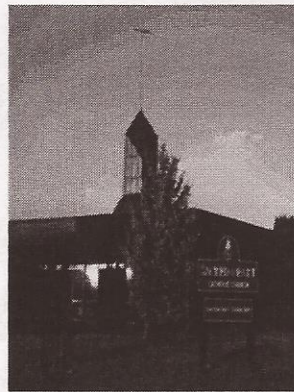

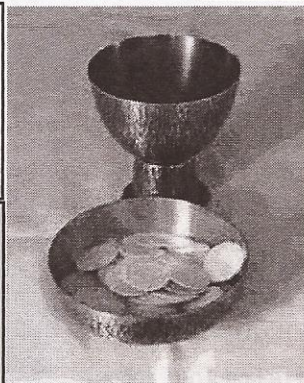

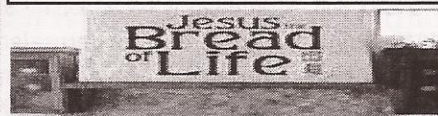
**Altar Society and Volunteers** Members and new volunteers are invited for orientation and planning on Tuesday 9 June at 5:00 pm after the afternoon MASS
