



For the financial year ending 31 January 2015 ADIG has allocated \$520,000 to be distributed to the parishes of the Diocese. This is an increase of \$70,000 on the amount available last year. In addition to the parish distribution ADIG has been able to distribute \$850,000 to the Diocese and \$30,000 to the Priests Retirement Foundation. This year Sacred Heart Parish Inverell receives \$32,647.00
