ORDINARY TIME—FEAST OF SANTO NINO



Today, we are celebrating the Feast of Santo Nino.

The Holy Child's **feast** is liturgically celebrated every third Sunday of January, during which devotees carry a portable **Santo Niño** image into the church during dancing celebrations. The image is one of the most beloved and recognizable cultural icons in the Philippines, found in both religious and secular areas.

Sinulog: The tradition SINULOG DANCE is a form of prayer through dancing. Devotees or people cry out to Sto. Nino—Infant Jesus—God in one voice—” Pit Senyor.” The first word “Pit” which means calling the attention of God for a particular or personal intention to be heard. “ Pit Senyor” - a combined word with two meanings—Calling God and and Prayer Intention.
