

RDINARY TIME—FEAST OF SANTO NINO



Today, we are celebrating the Feast of Santo Nino.

The Holy Child's **feast** is liturgically celebrated every third Sunday of January, during which devotees carry a portable **Santo Niño** image into the church during dancing celebrations. The image is one of the most beloved and recognizable cultural icons in the Philippines, found in both religious and secular areas.

Sinulog: The tradition SINULOG DANCE is a form of prayer through dancing. Devotees or people cry out to Sto. Nino—Infant Jesus—God in one voice—"Pit Senyor." The first word "Pit" which means calling the attention of God for a particular or personal intention to be heard. "Pit Senyor" - a combined word with two meanings—Calling God and and Prayer Intention.
