The opportunity to work with children, young people and vulnerable adults is a privilege. This guide will assist to clarify appropriate conduct to ensure that children and vulnerable adults are protected from harm.

Some examples of child related activity in a parish

- Children's liturgy
- Youth groups
- Altar servers supervision
- Special Religious Education (Catechetics)
- ☑ Youth choirs or music groups
- Junior Vinnies

What is acceptable behaviour

- ☑ Treating people with respect
- Providing a welcome, inclusive, safe environment
- Respecting differences
- Reporting concerns
- Being transparent in your actions

What is unacceptable behaviour

- Shaming, humiliating, belittling or degrading children
- Using inappropriate, offensive or discriminatory language
- Doing things for a child that they are able to do for themselves such as assistance with toileting or changing clothes
- Taking a child to your home or sleeping in the same room or bed as a child
- Image: Taking a child in your motor vehicle
- Smacking, hitting or physically assaulting a child
- Seeking to make special friends with a child
- Giving children secret gifts or cards without parental permission
- Being alone in a room with a child
- Touching a child in a sexual manner or asking them to touch you
- Photographing children without parental permission
- Showing pornographic material in any format
- Making friends with children on social media, contacting them by phone messages or emails
- Allowing unsupervised access to your phone or computer
