**We dwell within Your gentle embrace.**

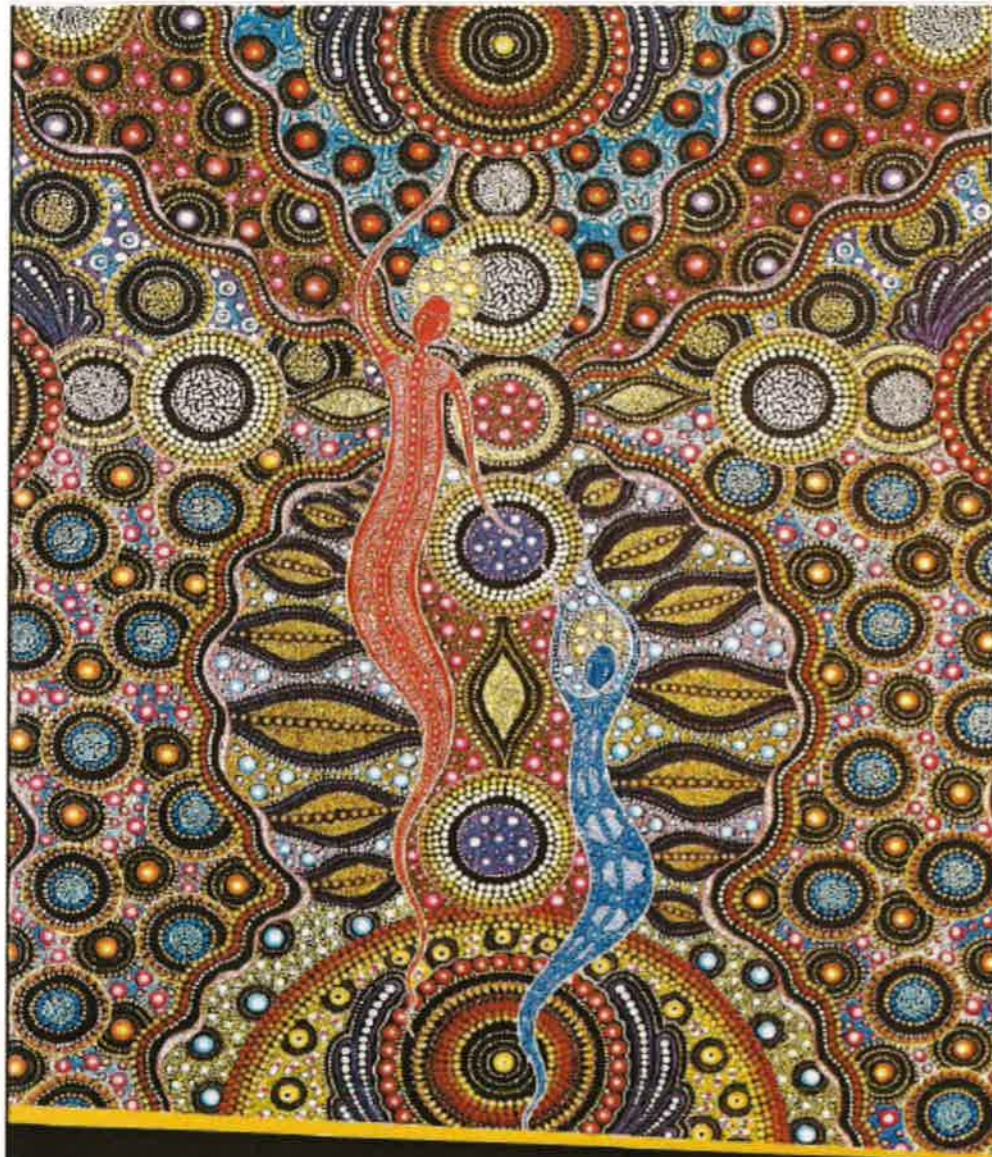

**Come Holy Spirit of Faith**

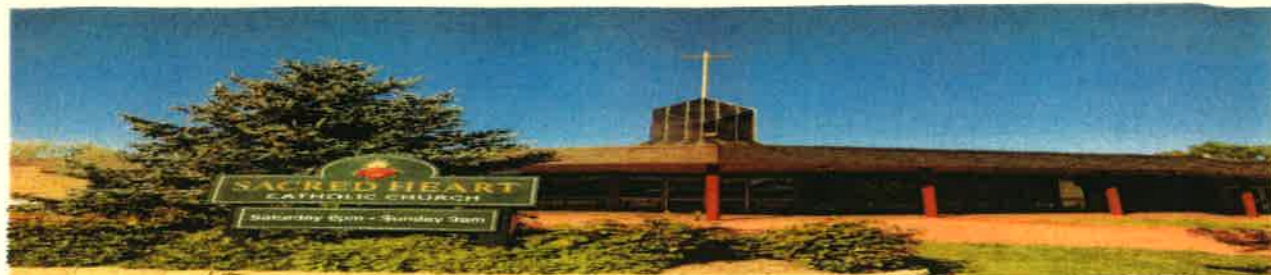
Empower our community to be courageous;

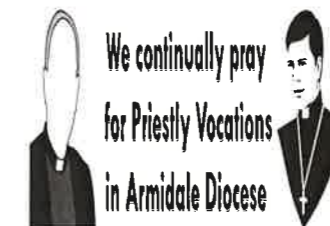
