The Advent wreath, or Advent crown, is shaped in a perfect circle to symbolize the eternity of God and God's infinite love. Usually a horizontal evergreen wreath with four candles, sometimes with a fifth white candle in the center (Christ candle). generally represent the four weeks of the Advent season as well as "the light of God coming into the world through the birth of Jesus Christ".

Beginning with the First Sunday of Advent, the lighting of a candle can be accompanied by prayers. An additional candle is lit during each subsequent week until the last Sunday before Christmas. The fifth candle is lit at Christmas Eve or Christmas Day reminding Christians that Jesus is the light of the world. During each Sunday of the Advent, we focus on one of the four virtues Jesus brings us:

Hope, Love, Joy and Peace.

Advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming." Jesus is coming. Advent is intended to be a season of preparation for His arrival. While we typically regard Advent as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a period of preparation, much like Lent. Prayer, penance

and fasting are appropriate during this season.

Advent is not as strict as Lent, and there are no rules for fasting, but it is meant to be a period of selfpreparation. The purple colour associated with Advent is also the colour of penance. The faithful should fast during the first two weeks in particular and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
