We rejoice with the Filipinos Community of our parish as they celebrate the feast of **Santo Niño** (Holy Child). Santo Nino is a **Roman Catholic** title of the **Child Jesus**, associated with a religious image widely venerated as miraculous by **Filipino Catholics**. An **image of Jesus as a small boy typically dressed as a king is a mainstay of Philippine Catholic life**. Devotions to him are part of every parish's life, and in some places a major feast of the year. Some image of Santo Niño is found in almost every Filipino home, because Filipinos believe that the Santo Niño is their protector and has the power to grant and answer their prayers. It is oldest Catholic relic in the Philippines, originally given in 1521 as a gift by explorer **Ferdinand Magellan** to **Rajah Humabon** and his wife as a baptismal gift. The statue bears **imperial regalia** including a gold crown and various scepters, wears fine vestments, and possesses jewelries mostly offered by devotees over several centuries.

The image is replicated in various parts of the country with different titles and is one of the most beloved and recognizable Filipino cultural icons. The annual dancing feast of **Sinulog** is held every January on the third Sunday in its honor. *We appreciate their contributions and supports in this Parish. May God bless us all as we celebrate what they were given ...*
