

### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT /C

Lent is the six weeks period leading up to Easter Sunday. The actual length is 46 days – however, 40 of these are fasting days and six are Sundays. Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter". The period of Lent is seen as a time of solemn observance and preparation for the celebration of the death and resurrection of Jesus at Easter. From its start on Ash Wednesday until its conclusion on Easter Sunday. Lent has been a traditional time for fasting or giving something up or abstinence. On Ash Wednesday many Christian churches hold services during which Christians are marked on the forehead with a cross of ashes. This is a sign of saying sorry to God for any wrong doing (penitence) and mortality. The ashes come from burning the palm crosses from Palm Sunday of the previous year. May God strengthen our faith as we
