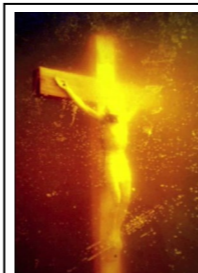

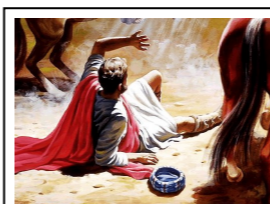

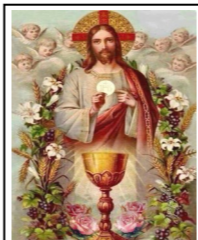
Enlightenment Prayer
