Food for thought
 We believe that Jesus Christ is really, truly, and substantially present in His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, on our altars: under the appearance of bread and wine. How do we know it? Our Lord told us "This is My Body...This is my Blood."
 Transubstantiation is the total change of substance of bread into the Body of Christ and of the substance of wine into the Blood of Christ at the moment of consecration. While the bread and wine retain the appearance and physical makeup of bread and wine, in reality God has changed their substance into the Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus Christ is therefore truly and physically present in each consecrated host. What a pity, then, that so many receive Him in Holy Communion with indifference and lack of care. He is our sanctification and redemption. Therefore, let your reception of Him be done in loving reverence. Prepare yourself mentally and spiritually through prayer and confession to receive Jesus in a worthy manner.

 Loving Father, we pray today for our catechists. We thank you for their gift of ministry in Your church. Grant them Your wisdom that they may grow in the understanding and teaching of Your Word. June - the Holy Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus!

The symbol of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a calling for all to put Jesus Christ into the centre of their lives.

In June we especially honour the humility, love and mercy of Our Blessed Lord Who died in atonement for our sins.

Let us not forget His tremendous sacrifice and strive to make reparation for all the grave offences we commit against His Sacred Heart through our sinful pride and arrogance.

Several ways we can honour the Sacred Heart of Jesus during June are:

1. Pray a Prayer to the Sacred Heart each day;
2. Visit a Catholic Church at least once a week and spend time in front of the Blessed Sacrament;
3. Give up something (like in lent) in reparation for the offenses committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus;
4. Pray the Rosary each day and reflect upon the life of Christ.

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus can be transferred in our Parish to the next Sunday, 18th June. All Masses in our Parish that day will be of the Sacred Heart. After Mass, there will be the opportunity to make the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to which is granted a Plenary Indulgence under the usual conditions.
