The Effects of Holy Communion in Five Parts (Fr J Brent)

1. The primary cause of the growth of grace is the Eucharist, and receiving holy communion has many wonderful effects in us. It comes as a surprise to many people to hear that the Eucharist is a cause, but realising this simple truth helps us to receive the effects or fruits of holy communion. Just as food nourishes a child and causes the child to grow strong in the bodily life, so holy communion nourishes our souls and causes us to grow strong in the spiritual life - the life of grace. Besides causing growth, food also has many other effects on our bodily life. Food serves to recover us from sickness, preserve us from becoming sick in the future, and energise us when we have grown sluggish. Holy communion works similar effects in the spiritual life of grace in our souls.

Food for thought

Not every desire comes from the Holy Spirit, even though it seems good to you. It is difficult to judge rightly whether a good or evil spirit urges you to desire this or that, or whether you are prompted by your own spirit. Many have been deceived in the end who at first thought they were guided by the Holy Spirit. Therefore, it is with fear of God and a humble heart that you should desire and ask for whatever comes to your mind as desirable. With entire abandonment of yourself to God, commit all things to Christ, saying: "Lord, You know what is best for me; let it be done according to Your will."
