The Church will be open for private prayer and the Rosary Monday to Friday and those hours will be published each week in the Parish Bulletin. If you wish to have a copy of the full Mass schedule for October, there are some copies available at the entrances to the church.

Daylight Saving starts this Sunday at 2am. Those using traditional clocks, don't forget to put them forward 1 hour.
