Food for thought
 The depth of our love for God must be measured by the desire we have to suffer for His sake. It is easy to say the words 'I love God', but to put those words into action requires courage, especially in times of adversity and suffering. When the whole world persecutes you for your faith, when friends and family ignore or mistreat you, when financial difficulties or ill health beset you, it is at those times when you can prove your love for God. With simple acts of charity and forgiveness, with trusting patience in the face of suffering, we can use all occasions of trouble and grief as moments to live out our call to love our neighbour and to love God at all times and to offer Him praise at every moment.



Praying the Rosary
 During the month of October (being the month of the Most Holy Rosary) the Holy Rosary will be prayed half an hour before each weekend Mass. There are pamphlets available that provide a step-by-step guide on how to pray the Rosary at the paper table, along with free Rosary beads.

All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day
 On All Saints' Day there is a call to live as saints, to remind us how we are supposed to live. On All Souls' Day we offer prayers for those in Purgatory and ask for God's mercy upon them.
Prayer: Eternal Father, I offer You the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the souls in Purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal church, those in my own home and within my family. Amen.

For the Souls in Purgatory – Plenary Indulgence
 A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted each and every day from November 1st to Nov 8th, is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and there pray the Our Father and the Creed for the departed.

Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- Do the work while in a state of grace,
- Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work (several plenary indulgences may be earned per reception),
- Receive Eucharistic communion within several days of the indulgenced act (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception),
- Pray for the pope's intentions (One Our Father and Hail Mary)
- Have no attachment to sin (even venial) – i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin.
