St Joseph, pray for us. St Charles Borromeo, patron saint of bishops, pray for us.

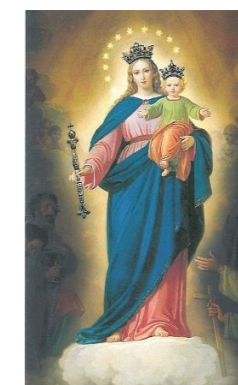
Prayer in Honour of the Holy Name of Jesus
