Note on the SACRED PASCHAL TRIDUUM of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord: The Triduum is the most solemn liturgical celebration of the Church. It celebrates the mystery of our faith, the mystery of our salvation. The word Triduum means three days - what we have is a three-day celebration but **ONE** continuous Liturgy. It is **ONE** celebration spread over three days. Hence, there are no dismissals on Thursday evening and Good Friday. The Final Blessing is at the end of the Easter Vigil.

2nd APRIL : HOLY THURSDAY

6:00pm – Mass of the Lord’s Supper and Washing of the Feet

* Followed by **ADORATION** and Confession.

(Today, gifts for the poor may be presented by the community: this would be a good time for people to make their **PROJECT COMPASSION** offering.)



3rd APRIL : GOOD FRIDAY

10:00am – Stations of the Cross

3:00pm – Celebration of the Passion of the Lord and Adoration of the Holy Cross



4th APRIL : HOLY SATURDAY

7:00pm – EASTER VIGIL

*The **EASTER VIGIL**, the mother of all vigils, is the greatest and the most noble of all solemnities.

5th APRIL : EASTER SUNDAY

9:00am – TINGHA: Easter Sunday Mass

THREE PILLARS OF LENT:

1. FASTING is the act of doing with less. In the Catholic Church, those aged 18 - 59 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (Canon 97). On such days, those fasting may eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals.

2. Days of ABSTINENCE during Lent are Fridays, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics over the age of 14 are expected to abstain from the eating of meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays throughout the Lenten Season (Canon 1250 -1253).

3. ALMSGIVING refers to the act of giving help, goods, or performing acts of charity to the poor and those in need. The Catholic Church regards almsgiving as a witness to fraternal charity and a work of justice that is pleasing to God.
